Standard:

Materials:

Fall - Leaves (real/fake) - paint/paper Summer - water play (pool and/or ice) Spring - flowers/umbrellas/butterflies Winter - snow/ice/snowflakes (paper, ice)

Procedure:

Fall - paint with leaves or leaf rubbing - Leaf Man book Summer - paint with ice Spring - color changing flowers Winter - add in snow

Adaptations:

Child doesn't have strong motor skills - throwing "snowballs" - roll the "snowball" have crumpled paper instead, throw large puff, help support them while throwing (hand over hand)

Child with speech - Teach signs for seasons (with all children too)

Assessment:

Observe and record what children say about the differences in seasons. Record anything they say.
